

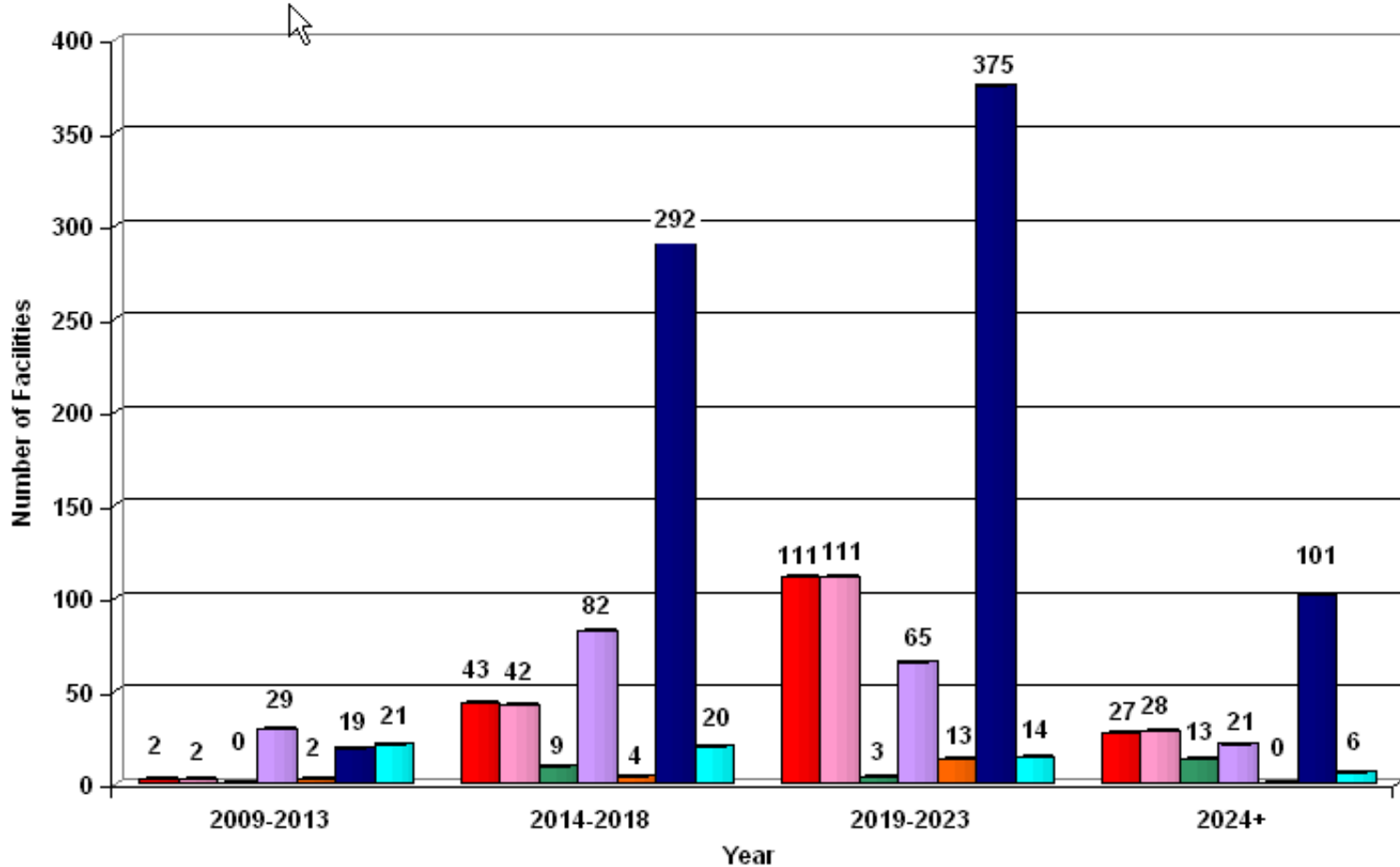
# UK Southern North Sea Consolidated Data

- All others are UK only.

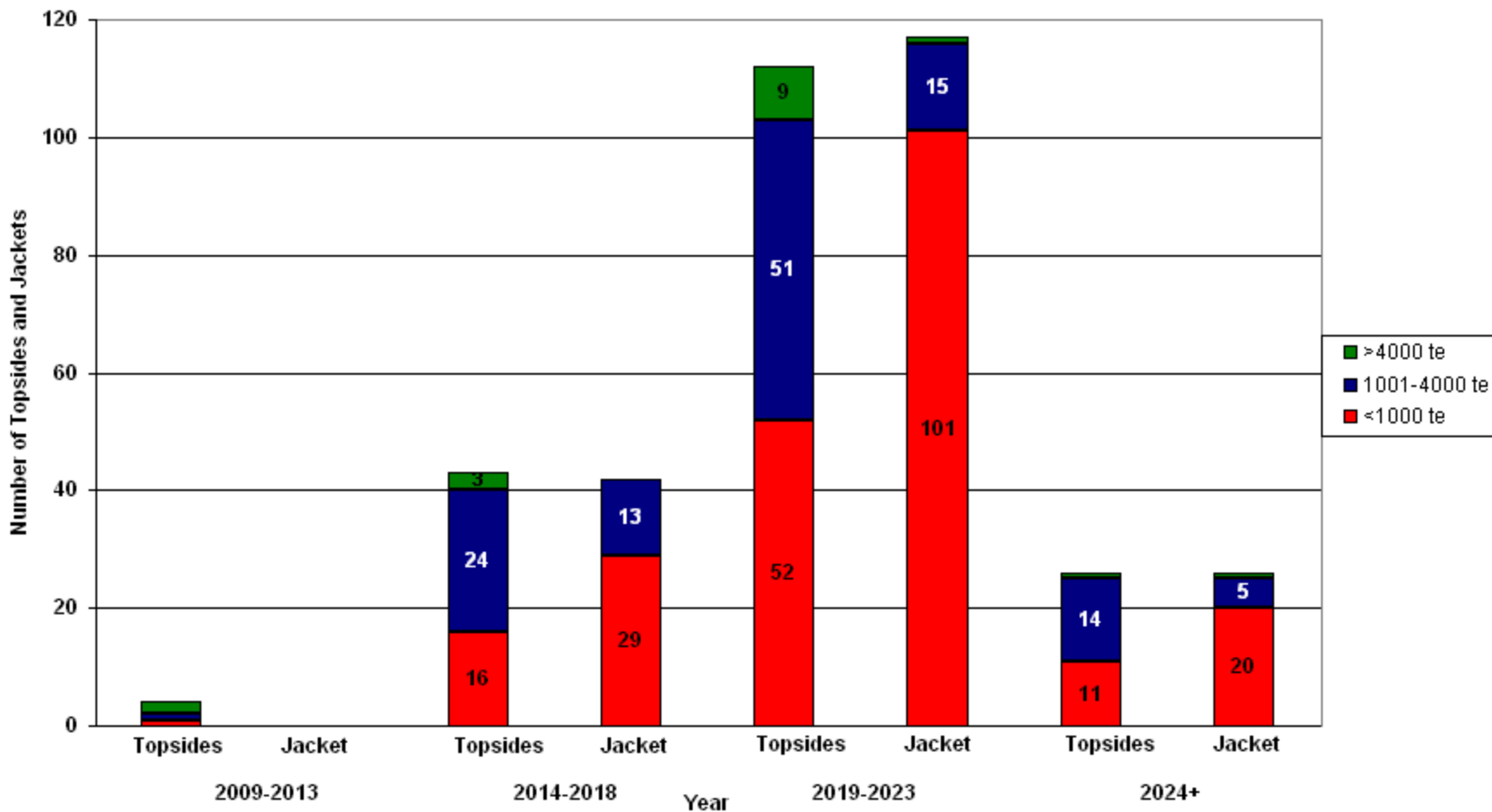

### Number of Facilities to be Decommissioned SNS UK Sector

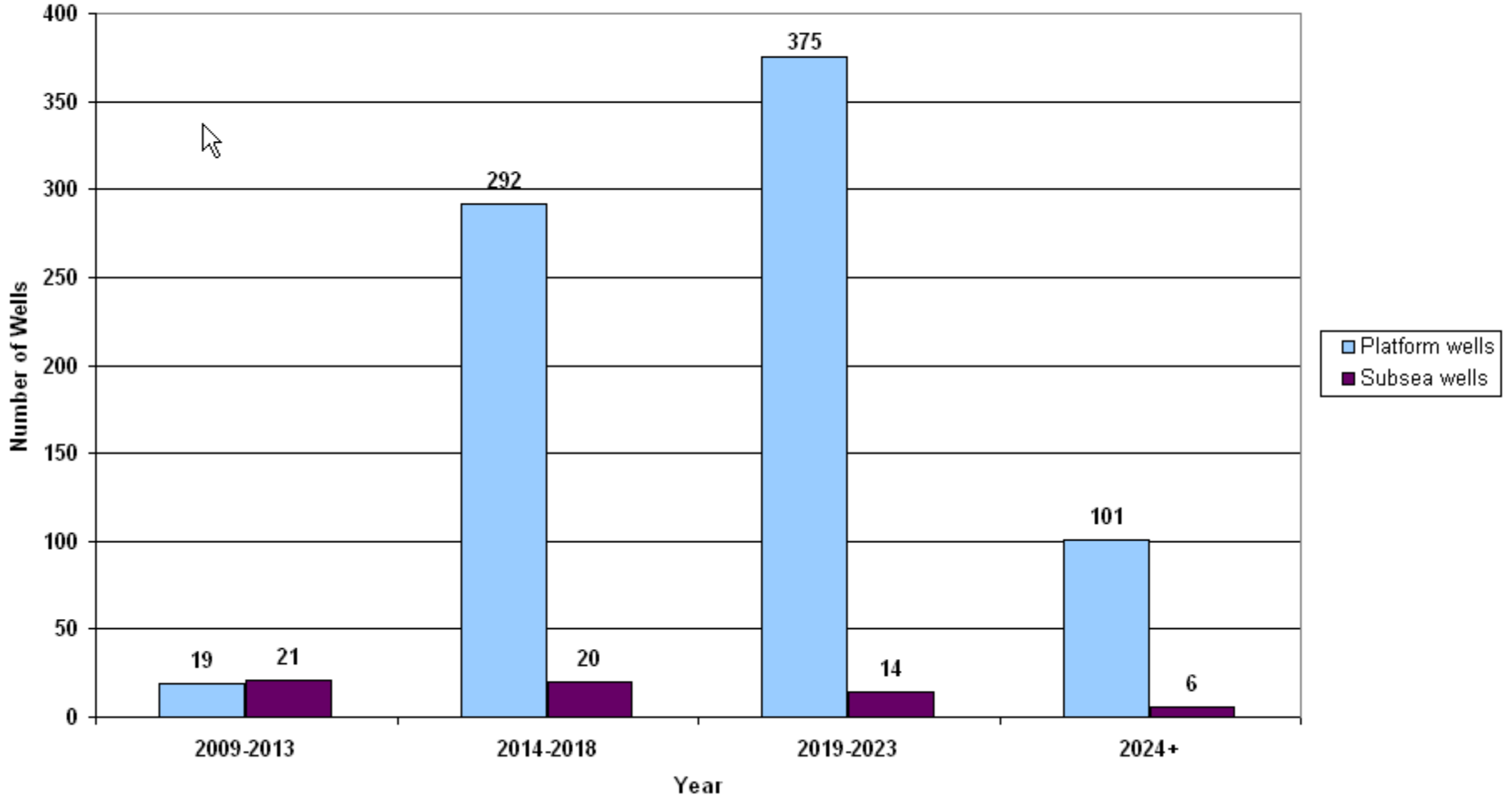
